On the Move (OTM) is the network for cultural mobility information active in Europe and worldwide. Established in 2002 as a website, OTM has developed and widened and today constitutes a **network** of 34 organisations and individual members based in 22 EU and non-EU countries, supporting cultural mobility through **information and advocacy** activities.

Mission and strategy

OTM mission is to encourage and facilitate cross-border mobility and cooperation, contributing to building up a vibrant and shared European cultural space that is strongly connected worldwide.

OTM's strategic plan 2011-2013 focuses on three main areas:

- Information OTM facilitates, coordinates and improves cultural mobility information provision in Europe and beyond;
- Advocacy OTM defends and promotes a concept of mobility that is progressive, responsible and sustainable from the social and environmental point of view;
- Networking OTM aims to build and improve its members' capacity to deal with mobility through exchanges and training.

Overall, OTM aims to position itself as the knowledge center about cultural mobility in Europe – and beyond.


Key issues 2012

In order to fulfil its objectives, in 2012 OTM will work together with the members focusing on the following issues:

- <u>Visa issues</u> OTM aims to position itself in the debate about visa issues: a crucial topic for the international mobility of artists and cultural operators, for EU external relations, and for human rights;
- Social issues related to cultural mobility OTM focuses on specific obstacles to cultural mobility related to social security regulations and establishes strategic partnerships with external experts to produce relevant information on related topics;
- Environmental issues OTM engages on raising awareness and find responses for the environmental impacts of cultural mobility.

All the activities planned for 2012 will feed into the *Charter for sustainable and responsible cultural mobility* that OTM will launch in early 2013 as the main output of its three-years strategic plan.

Membership

The strength of OTM lies in its members: **34 organisations**, diverse in nature and mission, joining forces and sharing knowledge to support the

mobility of artists and cultural operators through information coordination, advocacy and joint activities.

OTM members are active in various domains, ranging from the performing arts to visual and cross-disciplinary arts. 24 members are organisations, 10 members are networks.

OTM members are based in 22 EU and non-EU countries. All of them are active at the regional/international level (inter- and across the EU as well as with Third Countries) and through them, OTM's activities can reach out worldwide.
